## **Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup>**

- high 37.8°C (100.04°F) day.
- Low 27.1°C (80.78°F) highest low since Christmas Day 1868 (26.3°C).
- Second warmest night in Sydney's recorded climate history.
- 50 bushfires currently burning across NSW.

## **Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup>**

- High 37.2°C (98.96°F).

## **Thursday 15<sup>th</sup>**

- 21°C (70°F) about 4°C below average.
